Review Comments:

The Annual Funding Assessment provided valuable insights and suggestions that can guide future efforts and enhance contributions to the provincial sport system.

The following comments are related to some of the good practices and successes identified from the review:

- Your organization is to be commended on the many good practices including strong planning processes with regular monitoring, and positive club engagement.
- We would like to wish you continued success with the implementation of the "Plouf" program, which will further expose more individuals to the sport or diving in rural areas.
- The athlete testing program continues to be a success and has led to the development of strong athletes moving up into the high-performance area, and that the organization continues to produce many high-level divers and coaches that go on to national, international levels or move on to colleges/universities through scholarships.

The following comments represent key issues and challenges identified from the review that the committee recommends for improvement:

- Overall, your organization rated well in financial management, however the area of revenue generation was identified as a challenge for the size of the organization but also an area of potential growth. It is encouraged that Dive Sask looks into more areas to bring in self-help revenue so the organization is less dependent on Lotteries Funding.

- The organization is encouraged to continue focusing on the development and recruitment of coaches to ensure further sustainability of the programs.
- It was noted that growth in the Under-Represented Populations and Indigenous Participation areas was limited due to lack of facility availability. The organization has been encouraged to reach out to Sask Sport resources for advice and guidance in this area.
